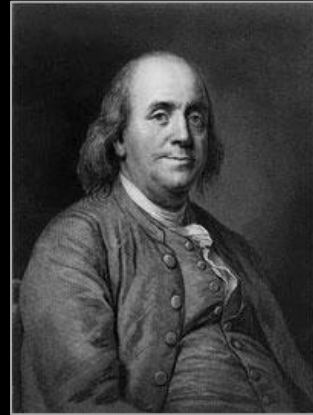

When Submitting Petitions

First, in our anxious joy to tender a petition for a friend or relative, it is easy to rush and miss some details. First and foremost, the petition must be **readable**. Please advise your petitioners to print rather than write in cursive. There is even a place to print his name. But be advised, a signature near the bottom and \$160.00 are required.

Next, before submitting, please read the petition from top to bottom.
