We have closed the deal & now own the property at 2411 N. Lafayette!

Our initial offer of \$50,000.00 was **rejected**, but then Mr. Larry Bennett came back with an offer to **DONATE** the building to us!! This does involve paying some expenses such as the realtor, deed transfer and other incidentals totaling \$6170.46 (\$5K reduced Realtor Fee) .

We are now the proud owners of a building, that is nestled in on nearly an acre lot. All of this, located on a major thoroughfare, abutting a nice residential neighborhood, and centrally located within the city.

Now the work begins! There are a number of tasks before us, including, modifying and upgrading the building, making our new home ready for our use, making it handicap accessible, procuring Lodge furniture and so forth.
